

Crop insurance – Hay and Pasture Coverage “Quality” Grid











































From the 2024 insurance year onwards, the “Quality” grid is based on the number of days suitable for harvesting.

Days Suitable for Harvesting

La Financière agricole considers a good day for harvesting when rainfall is less than

- 1 mm of rain
- 30 mm of rain the day before a suitable day for harvesting
- 50 mm of rain two or three days before a suitable day for harvesting

The following table provides a breakdown of the days that are suitable for harvesting.
