

The "Feed Requirements" option is based on the annual feed requirements for the insured's grazing animals in the Hay and Pasture Crop Insurance Program.

The annual feed requirement, including hay, forage corn, annual fodder, and pasture, is set at 5,300 kg of forage per animal unit. The annual feed requirement is expressed for each crop in kilograms at 15% moisture or 85% dry matter.

Animal units are based on the average mass of the same group of herbivores, according to the following equivalencies:
