

LAMBS Declaration Checklist



Who do I need to contact?

For DECLARATIONS, QUESTIONS or CORRECTIONS

- Declaration of birth (activation)
- Entry or exit declaration
- Declaration of entry at a shared site or one that does not belong to you
- Declaration of mortality
- Missing or irregular information at Agri-Traçabilité Québec (ATQ)
- Tag replacement
- Corrections: Site no., sex, date of birth
- Updating of inventory for abandonment or stop in production
- Change in ownership by “testimony” at a same raising site (sale without animals moving)

- Eligibility to Stabilization Insurance Program (ASRA)
- Calculation of the number of female breeders
- Calculation of the number of kg of lambs sold
- Calculation of the number of lambs sold
- Transfer of insurance coverage
- File closure (abandonment or stop in production)
- Reasons for ineligibility at FADQ
- Insurable volume and ASRA payments

For animals missing on the FADQ production statement

- Make sure you have made all your declarations to ATQ before contacting your FADQ representative

What weights will be used by FADQ?

For animals insurable under ASRA (Please keep proof that animals were marketed)

Actual weight when recognized stakeholders send information to ATQ

- Auctions inside Québec or outside Québec
- Slaughterhouses :
 - federal
 - provincial
 - local

The actual weight is also used when the sale to a broker is followed by an entry declared by one of these buyers when the events occur within the period of seven calendar days processed by FADQ.

Depending on the marketing method of heavy lambs, FADQ will recognize the weights sent to the ATQ by the Fédération des producteurs d'agneaux et moutons du Québec (FPAMQ).

Custom slaughter in federal or provincial slaughterhouses

Estimated weight

- Slaughterhouses or auctions inside Québec or outside Québec if not recognized for the weight
- Sale to a broker or other lamb producer
- Exit outside Québec (unknown buyer, i.e. without entry declaration on their site to the ATQ)

What animals are not insurable under ASRA?


- Custom slaughter in a local slaughterhouse
- Direct sale of live animals to a consumer
- Personal consumption
- Condemned animals

These conditions also apply to the marketing of heavy lambs supervised by the FPAMQ.

What to declare, to whom?


At ALL TIMES (ATQ)

Within seven days after the animals are tagged or the event

-  **Essential information for every declared event**
- **FADQ client** number and ATQ producer number
- Tag number
- Operation's site number (declaration site)
- Lamb production


All animal ENTRIES and BIRTHS (ATQ)

BIRTHS

-  **Essential information**
- Sex
- Actual date of birth

Tags must be affixed within 30 days of the birth or before the animal leaves the farm, whichever comes first

Animal PURCHASES AND MOVEMENTS


-  **Essential information**
- Site number of origin or the place of origin
- Date of entry on your site for each animal purchase or animal moved within Québec or outside Québec
- Date of entry or change in ownership on the site where animals are raised
- Date of entry of any movement on a shared site or a site that you do not own
- Sex and date of birth for purchases outside Québec

All animal EXITS and DEATHS (ATQ)

DEATHS

-  **Essential information**
- Date of death

SALE in Québec or outside Québec

-  **Essential information**
- Sale or exit date
- **Site number of destination** or place of destination

MARKETING

under the supervision and management of the FPAMQ


HEAVY LAMBS

Marketed by the Agence

- Tag number
- FPAMQ producer number
- Sales or exit date
- Buyer's site

Marketed by the producer


Transmit to the FPAMQ the *Form for direct sales to consumers «Formulaire des ventes directes aux consommateurs (P6)»* :

-  **Essential information***
- FADQ producer number
- Exact date of slaughter
- Number of site of slaughterhouse or the place
- Sign the local slaughterhouse sales register (*Registre des ventes aux abattoirs de proximité*)
- Keep the proof of the lambs' slaughter and proof of sale at least 2 years

The slaughterhouse must declare the slaughter to the ATQ and specify the actual weight of the slaughtered animals

SUBJECTS SOLD FOR REPRODUCTION

Transmit to the FPAMQ the *Form for breeding subjects* :

-  **Essential information***
- FPAMQ producer number
- Buyer's site number and contact information
- Date of sale (actual date of the transaction)
- Proof of registration in the GenOvis genetic evaluation program
- Proof of registration of 10% of female breeders in the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation

* The ATQ producer and FADQ client numbers identify the producer for whom the FPAMQ confirms the marketing. Date for sending documents to the FPAMQ for marketing by producers or of breeding subjects: the 15th of each month following the transaction. Deadline: March 15 following the end of the ASRA insurance year. This document may in no way take precedence over the *Règlement sur la vente en commun des agneaux lourds* (regulation on the joint selling of heavy lambs).
